**COVID COMMUNICATION NO. 09 of 2021**

Dear Residents

Fleming house and Resthaven have been in lockdown in terms of visits being paused during Gauteng's third wave.

Unfortunately, we have a positive case in MidCare so we will need to institute further precautions. With immediate effect the dining room will be closed and all meals will be taken in the Residents rooms.

This was carried out successfully last year and we will apply the same below guidelines for the next 14 days, which we will review.

All MidCare Residents will be confined to their individual rooms with all their meals/refreshments being delivered to them daily, in takeaway containers, including disposable plastic cutlery. There are dedicated nurses taking care of the MidCare Residents to avoid cross-contamination who administer medication which is dispensed by the Sister.

A nurse is on night duty for MidCare so that the frail care staff from Ground and First Floor are not in contact with these Residents.

MidCare Residents temperatures are checked daily and they are observed for any symptoms of the virus.
