Our Estate provides Seniors with a secure, vibrant (or tranquil if you prefer), stress free way of life amongst other like minded Seniors. Our professional management team and Board of Directors have the expertise required to effectively manage a retirement estate.

Life Right Homes on our Estate

Our homes provide a lock-up and go lifestyle for independent Seniors whilst also providing the convenience of a range of support services. You have security of tenure for the rest of your life and the peace of mind that comes from knowing that you have access to our excellent care accommodation, should it be required at any stage.

Our first one bedroom homes were built in the 1930's and we now have 205 beautiful homes at Randjes. We are continually looking at ways to improve what we offer our Seniors. One of the charming features of Randjes is that our Estate looks like a small suburb or village, with one in four of our homes being different (layout/design/size).

As homes become available we undertake a refurbishment to modernise and contemporise them.

The wait for a life right home can be lengthy particularly for our two bedroom options as this is what most of our applicants prefer. The wait is dependent on how many homes become available at any point and how many applicants on our waiting list are ready (or not) to make the transition to Randjes when we call.

We offer one, two and three bedroom homes of varying sizes. Some homes have a garage and others a carport. The majority of our homes are north facing.

The Randjes team takes care of pretty much all administrative matters, municipal bills, maintenance, access control, security, mowing of lawns and trimming of edges and the upkeep of communal gardens allowing you the time and freedom to enjoy your well-deserved retirement in a beautiful carefree environment.

Other aspects of choosing Life Rights

When purchasing a Life Right it is important to remember that you do not own the home you have selected. You are purchasing the right to live in your home, or in our care accommodation if applicable, for the duration of your lifetime.

Life Rights are governed by the Housing Development Schemes for Retired Persons Act, 65 of 1988 which safeguards both you as the purchaser and the seller.

Should you wish to leave our Estate, or in the event of your death, you or your estate/beneficiaries will receive a percentage back of the original purchase price as follows:

Period of Occupation	1 - 30 months	31 - 60 months	5 years & longer
Percentage pay back of original purchase price	75%	62.5%	50%

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Facilities and Services

We have many facilities and services available at Randjes for our Residents to enjoy.

- Our **Resthaven Lifestyle Centre** serves as a central hub for gathering and socialising with friends and includes:
 - **Lounge** with individual seating areas, big screen TV, puzzle table, two fireplaces and a large outdoor patio
 - **Bistro** – open Tuesday to Sunday for lunches and early dinners
 - **PerkUP** Coffee shop – open Tuesday to Sunday
 - **TopUP Convenience store**
 - Fully equipped **Gym**
 - **Heritage Room** – a history of Randjes and early Johannesburg
 - **Aladdins Cave** – our second-hand store
- **Guesthaven** – four guest suites to accommodate families visiting from out of town.
- **24-hour Security** with strict access control, electric fencing, cameras and patrols.
- **Medical panic button** in partnership with Medi-Response, you can be tracked wherever you are in South Africa where there is cell phone reception.
- **Estate Nurse** - runs a diabetic and blood pressure clinic once a week and is available for preventative nursing care and dressings.
- **Laundry** – your items are washed, ironed and folded for as little as R35 per dry kilogram*
- **Library** – reading (over 6 000 books), audio CD's and DVD's.
- **Transport to shops** – Norwood Pick n Pay, Killarney and Balfour weekly*
- **Transport to Doctors and hospitals** within a 15km radius*
- **3 course midday meal** available from our Fleming House dining room*
- **Professional Nurses** on site for emergencies.
- **Doctor Claudette Ginsberg** is on site Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings.
- **Hairdressers** on site three times a week.
- **Podiatrist** on site once a month and available for house calls.
- **Beautician** on site once a week.
- **Reflexologist** available for house visits.
- **Recuperative Care Facility** - 28 free days per annum in Fleming House for Life Righters.
- **Physiotherapist** available for house visits.
- **Biokineticist** – on site by appointment.
- **Fibre on the Estate** – the fibre backbone is owned by Vumatel. You would need to engage with an ISP (internet service provider) of your choice to get your WiFi connectivity up and running.
- **Postal** delivery to our post rooms.
